


1.4.1 Curriculum Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report

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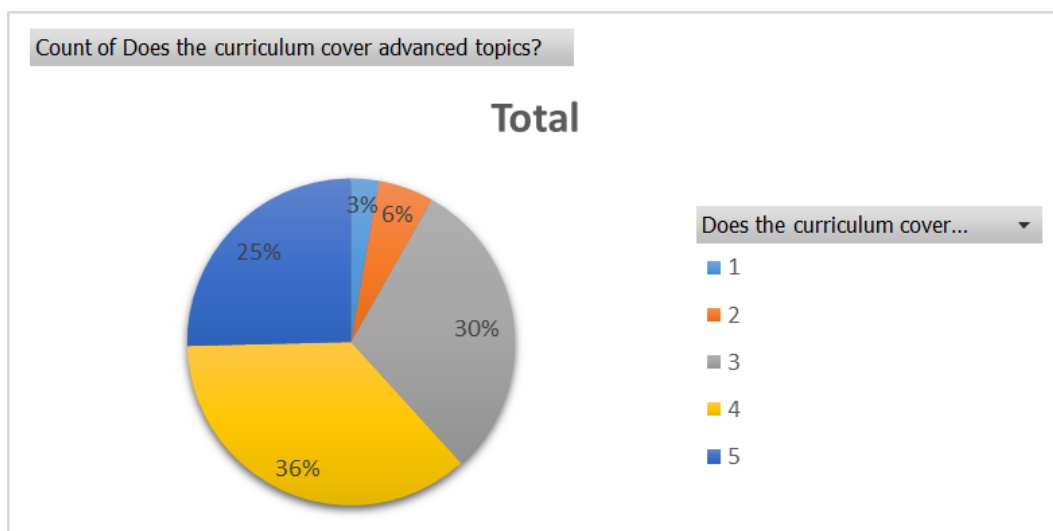

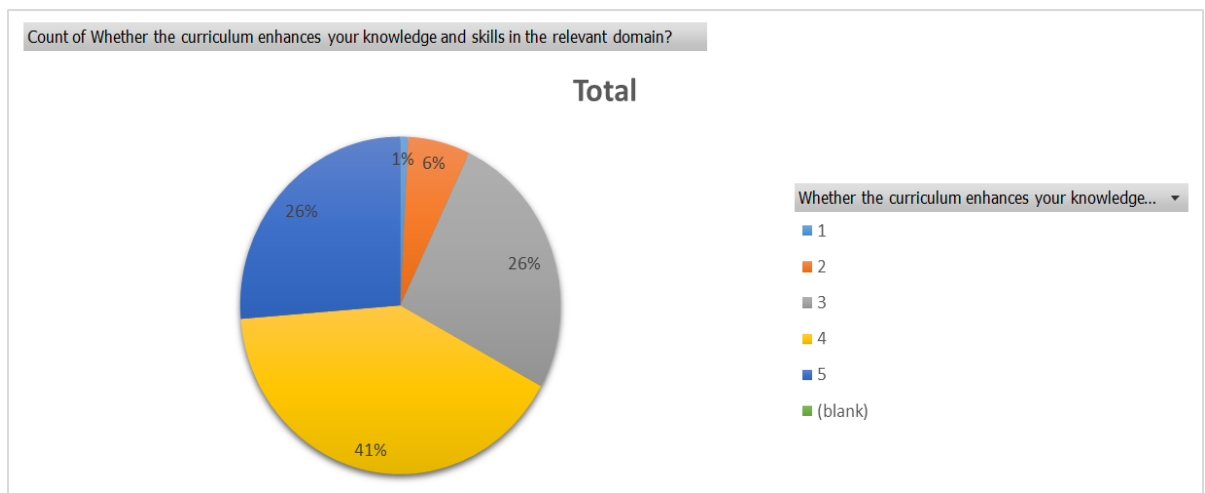

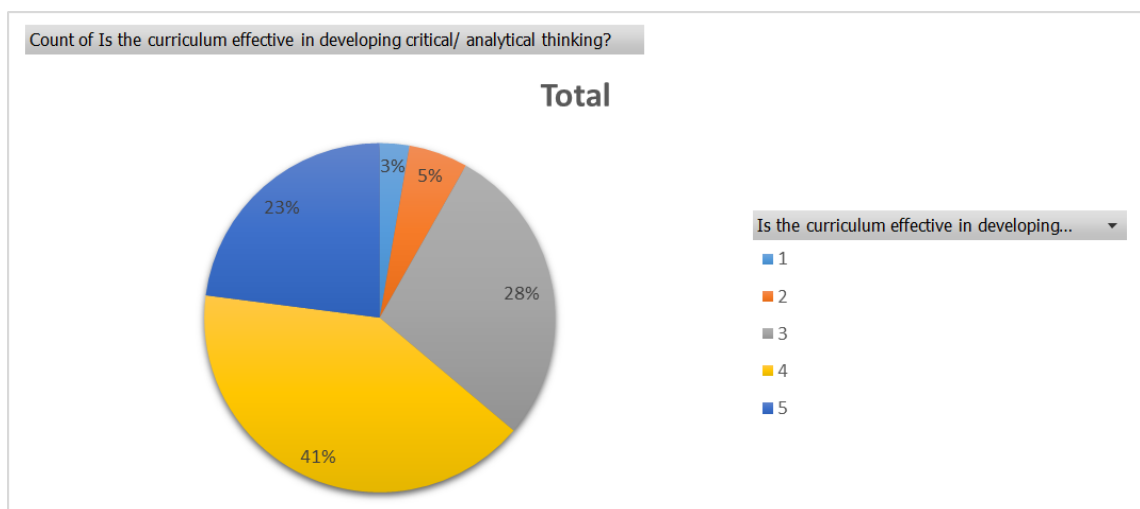

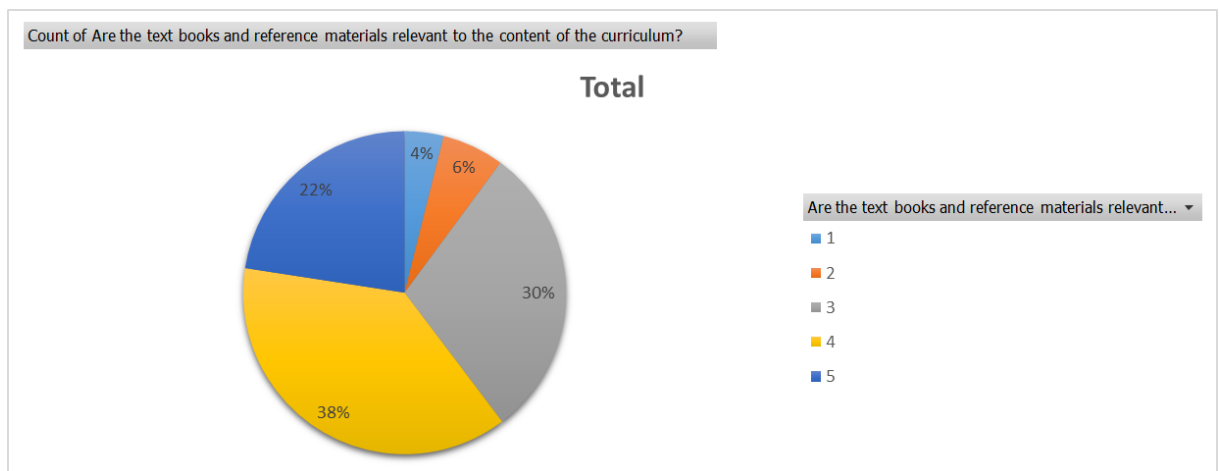

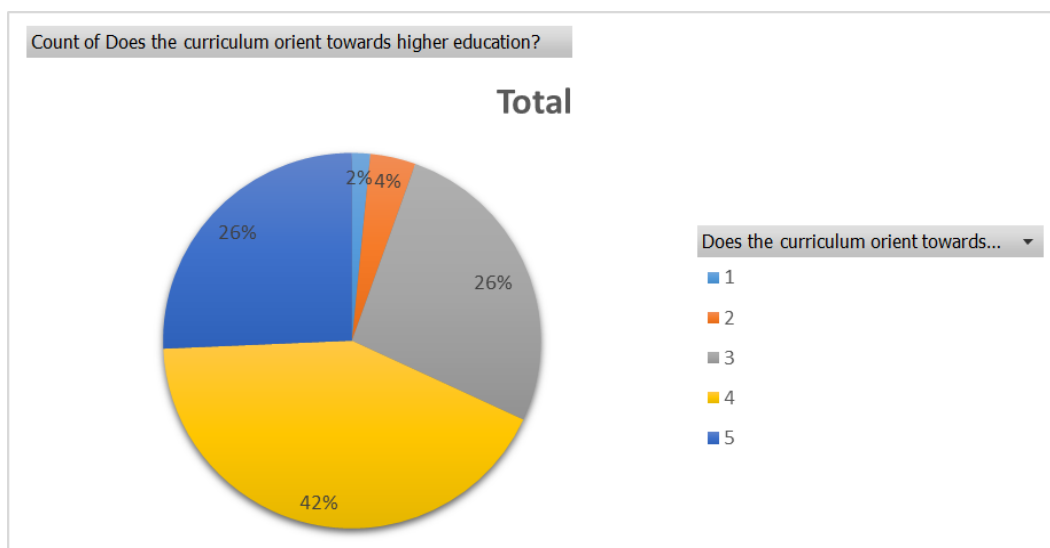

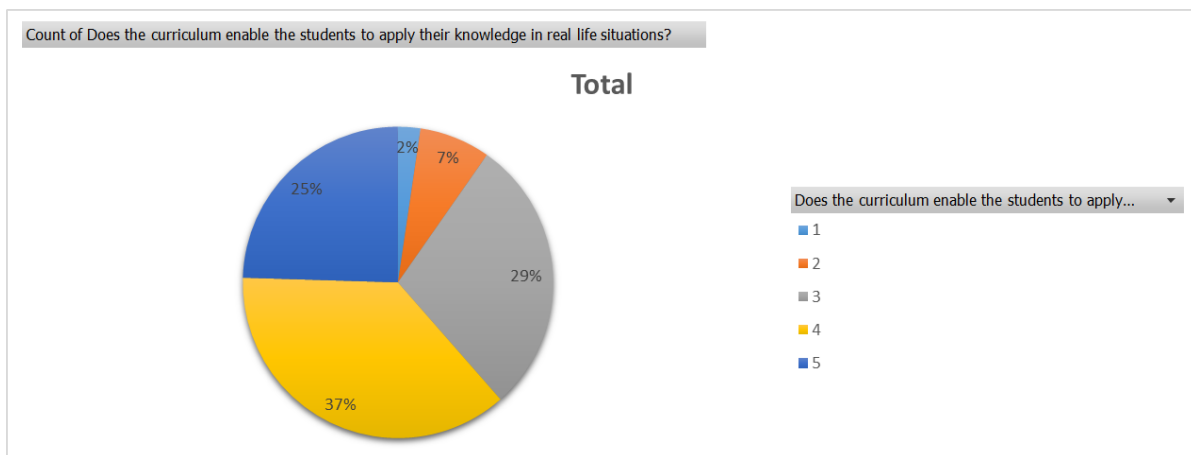

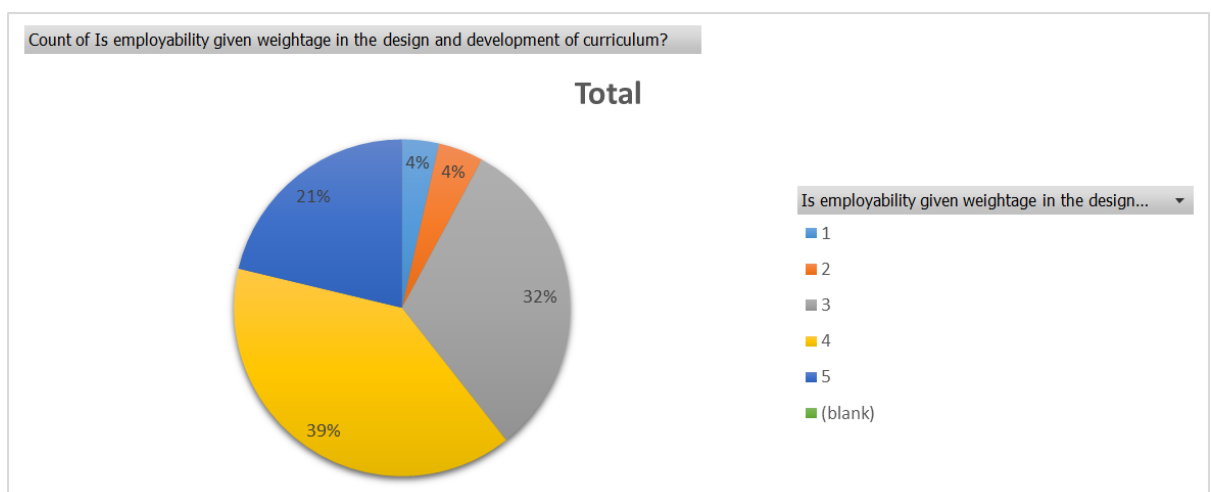

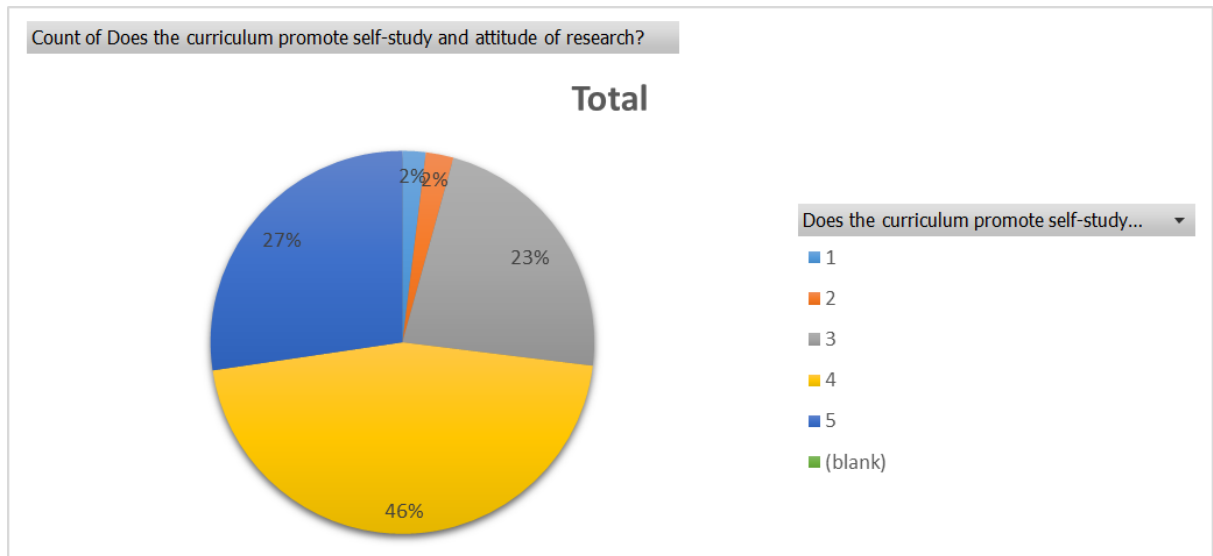

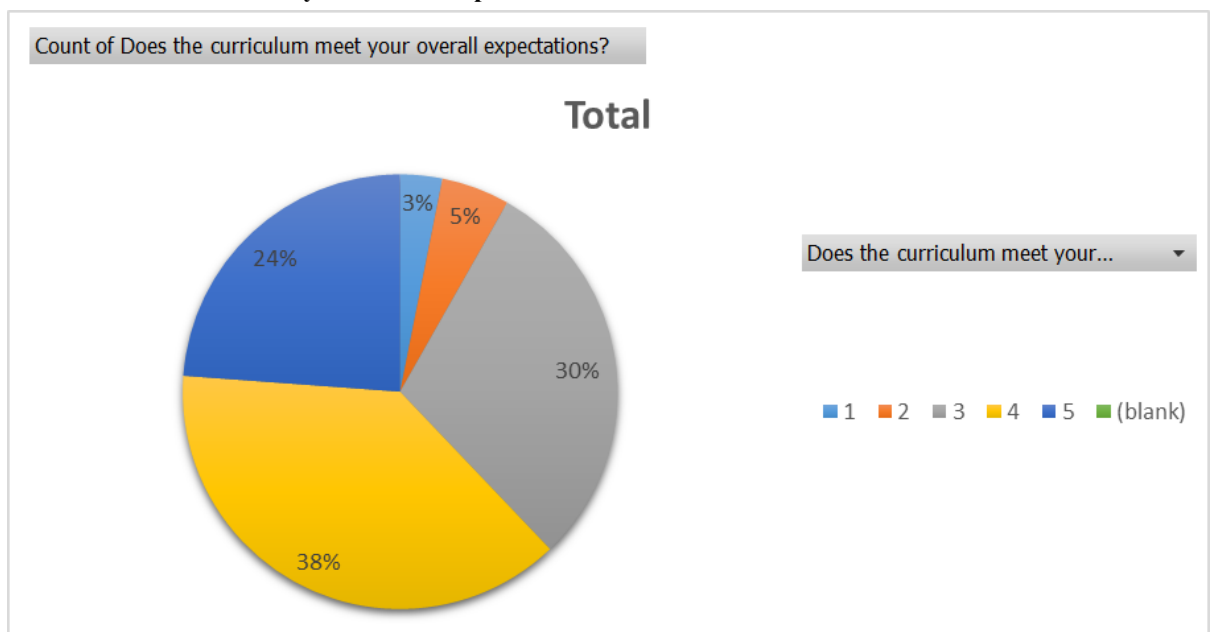

Action Taken Report

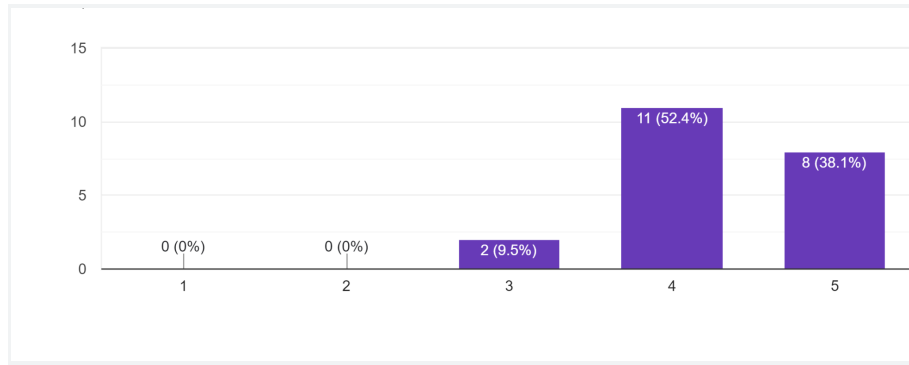

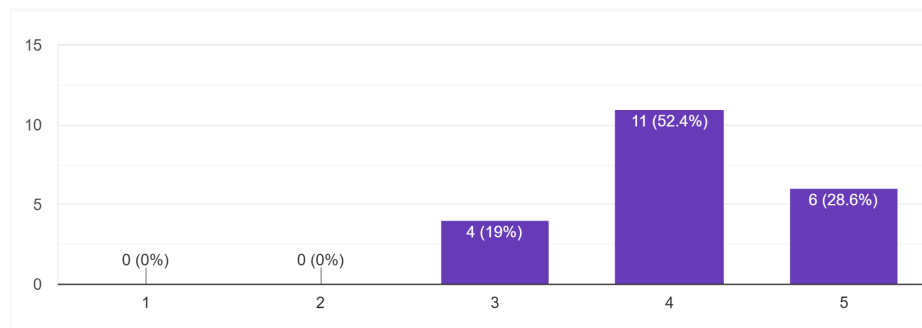

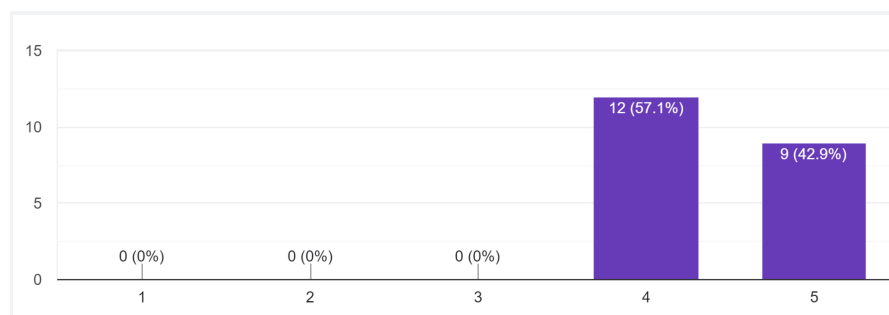

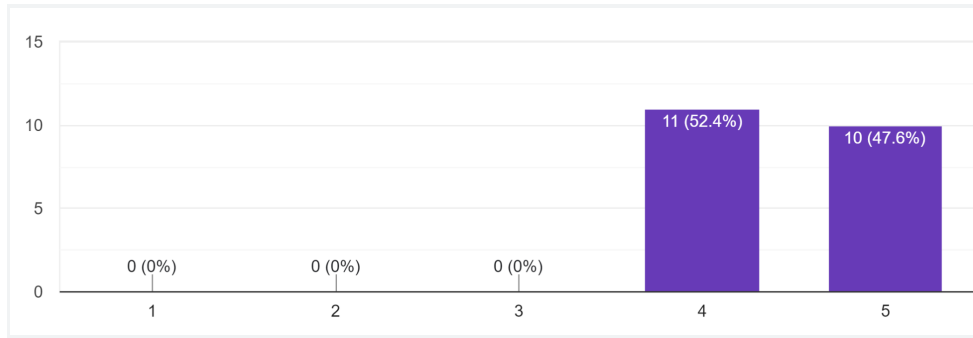

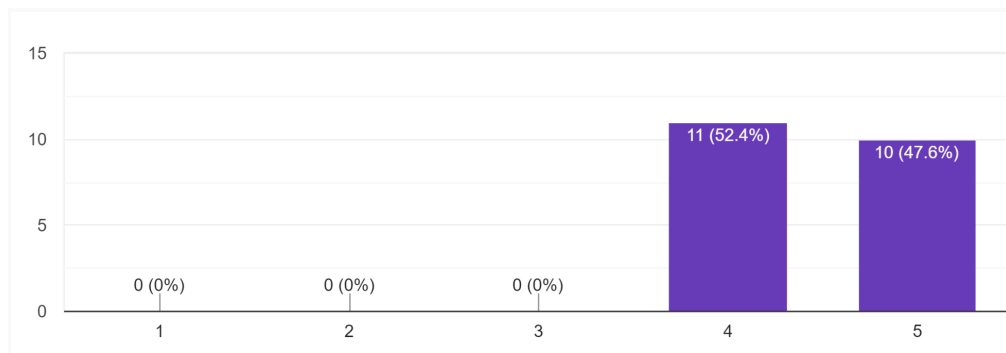

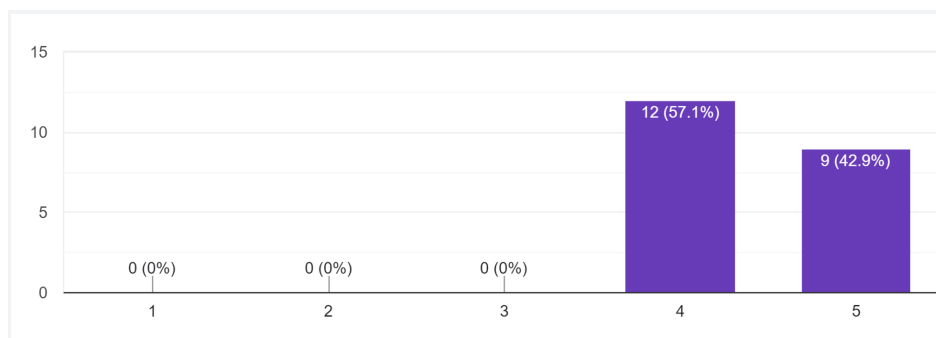

Action Taken Report



It's important to consider teachers' feedback. Teachers are better at knowing which students will quickly grasp the material and which would require additional time. Teachers therefore care for their students. In order to improve education, teachers' recommendations on the curriculum for all 4 programmes in the School of Commerce, Finance, and Accountancy for the odd semester of 2022–2023 were gathered.

The teachers of the respective programmes responded to the input. Using a Google form that asked them about their students' curriculum and syllabus, teachers provided feedback on the curriculum. A 5-likert scale was used to compile the responses. The School of Commerce, Finance & Accountancy was scheduled for a faculty meeting with the Programme Coordinators and the Head of the Department in response to the suggestions provided by the Teachers. It was then decided to discuss the modifications with the members of the Curriculum Development Committee (CDC). The meeting was held on January 5, 2023, to talk about the teachers' responses, and the main points were covered:

- What were the responses of Teachers?
- How far are the Teachers satisfied with the curriculum in the odd semester?
- For those who are not satisfied or not given the satisfactory feedback, points discussed on what has to be done in regard to that and how much changes are required in the curriculum in regard to the same?

The curriculum needs to be revised in the areas where Teachers were dissatisfied, as shown by the comments and the histograms given in the report above for various points, it was also decided during the meeting. The faculties have come to an agreement, and the reforms will start to be applied in the following semester.

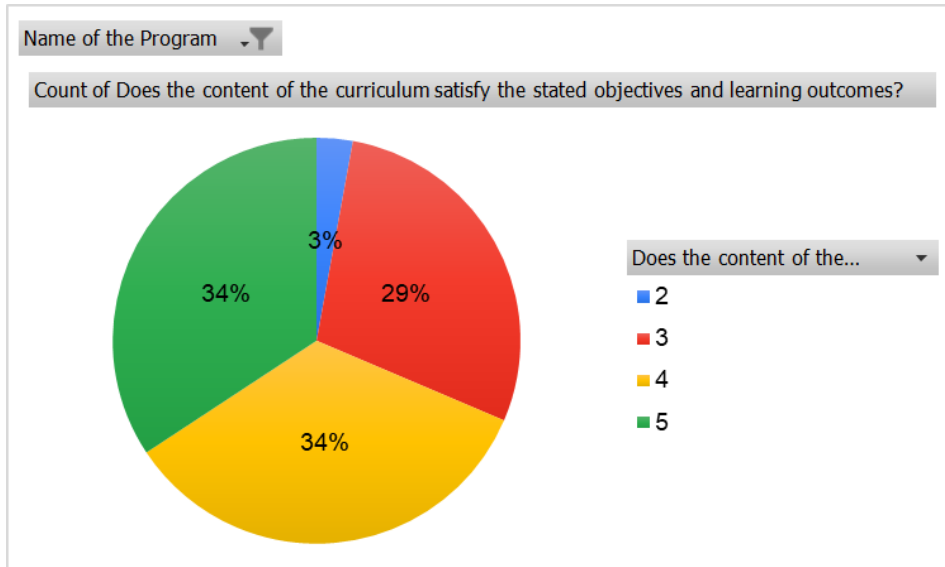

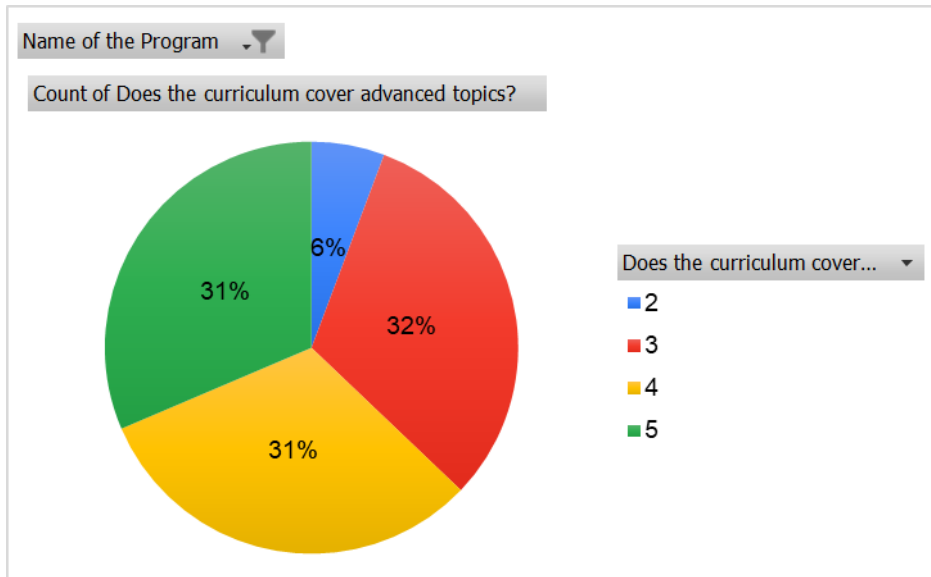

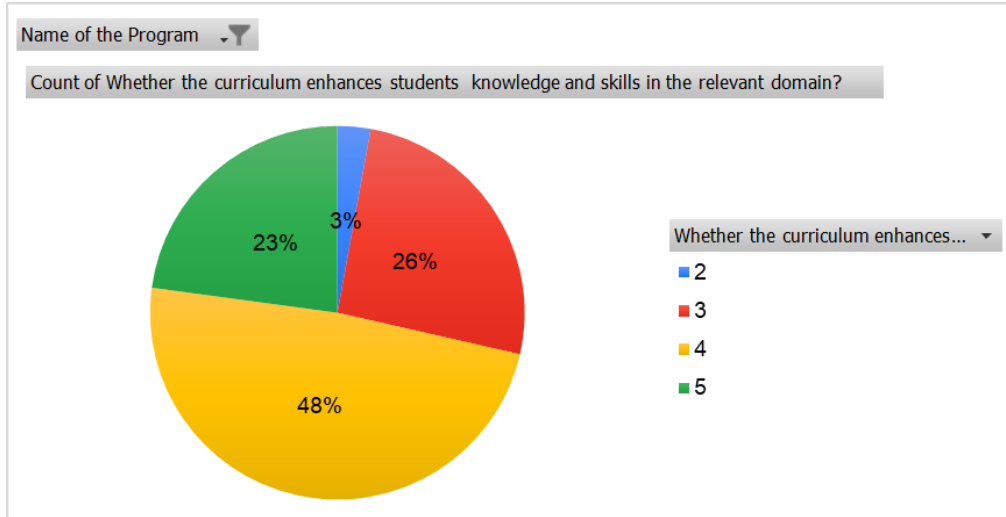

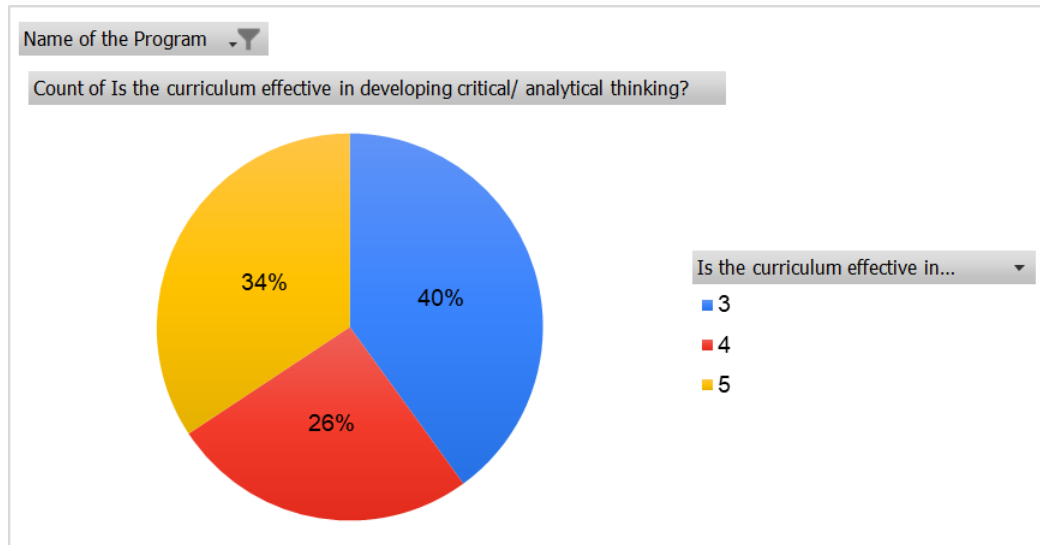

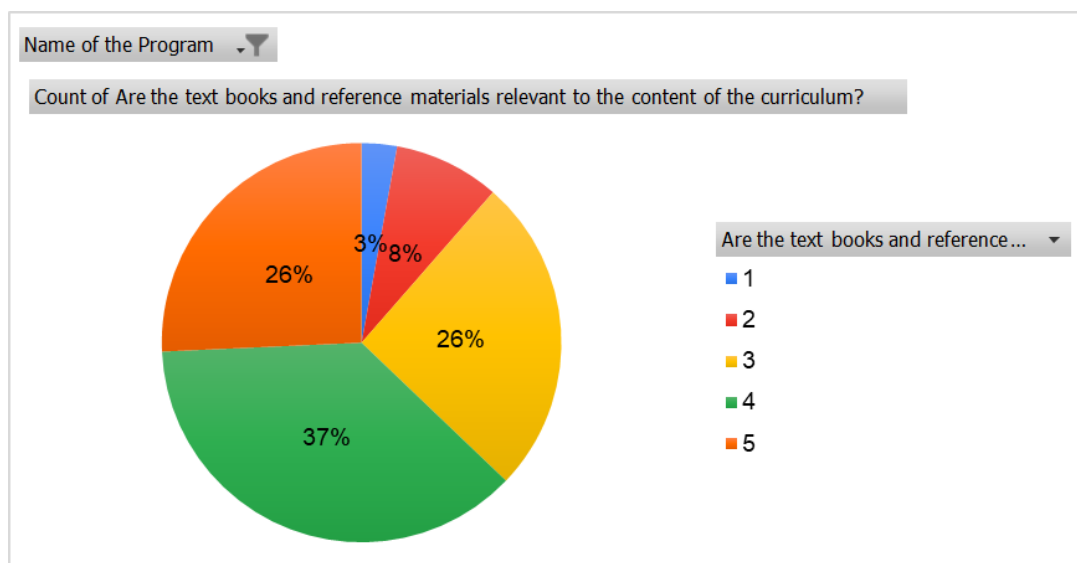

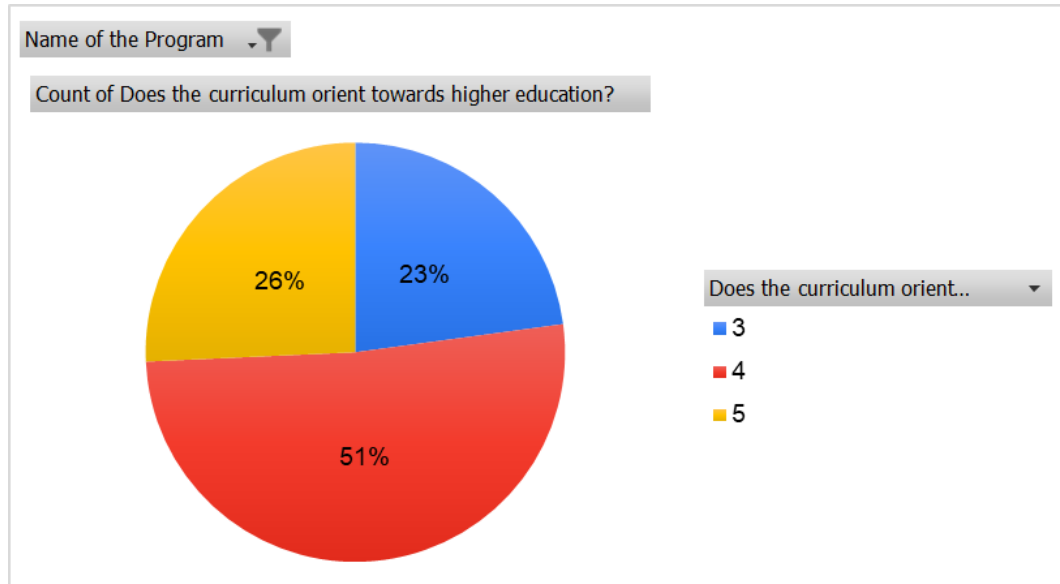

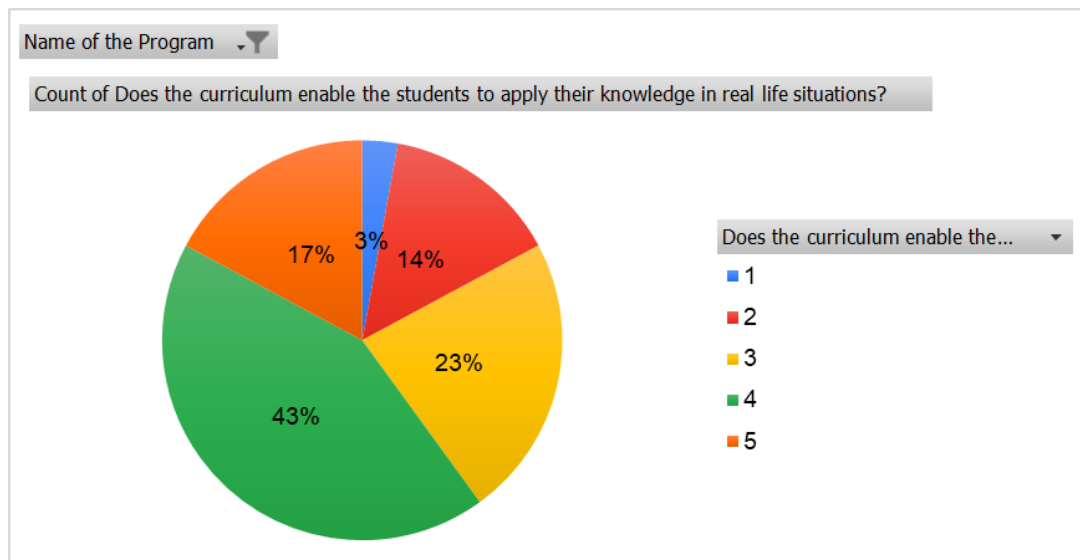

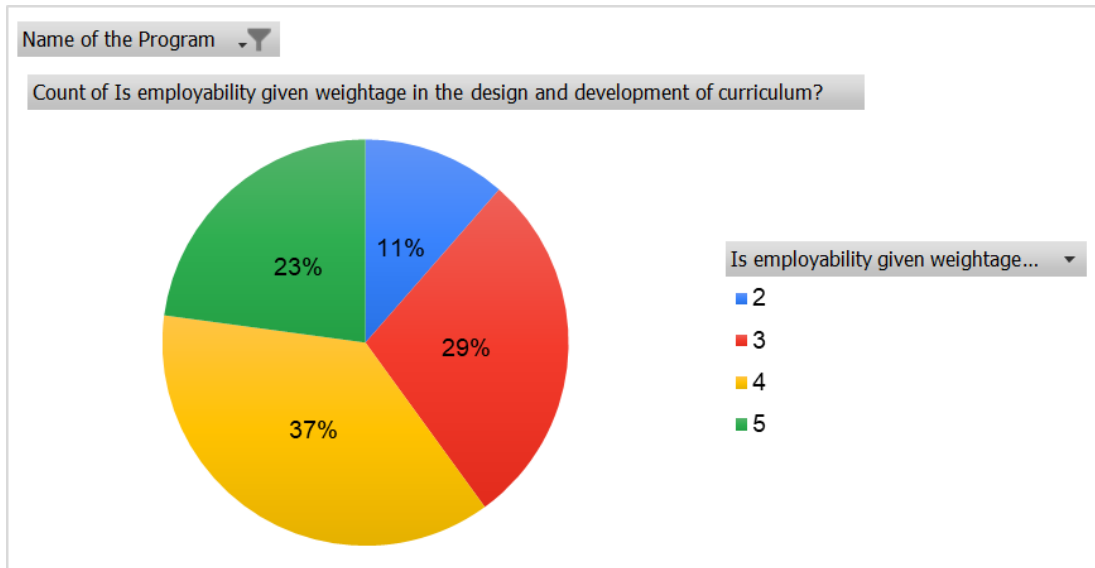

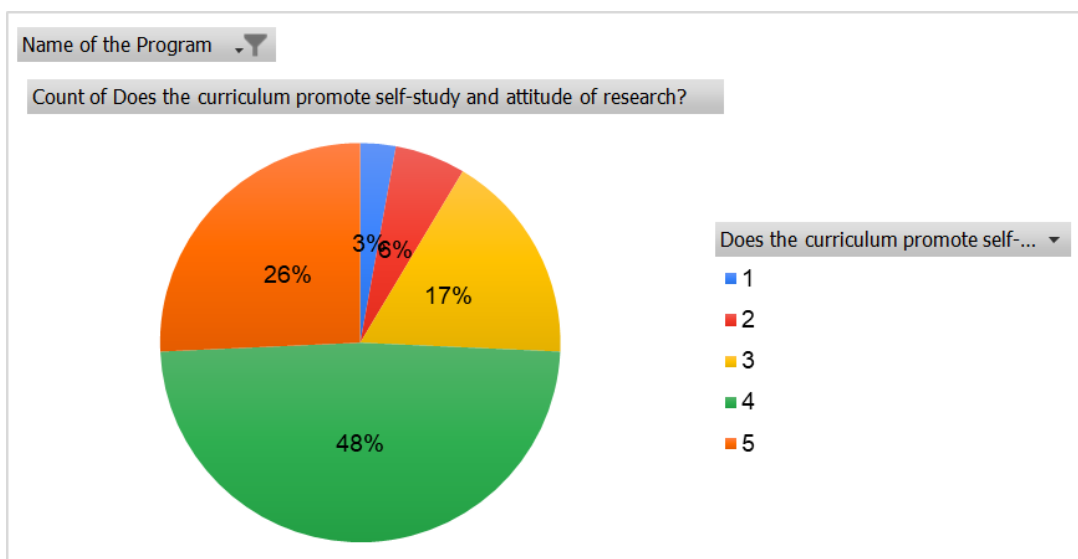

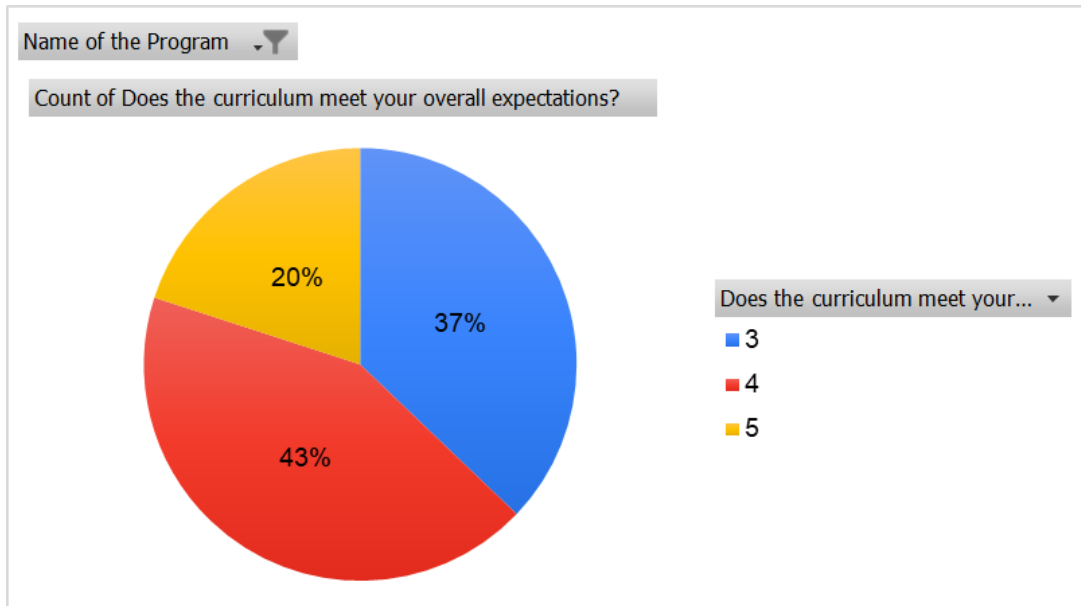

Action Taken Report

It is crucial to take parental feedback into account. Because it will impact their children's future, parents are very worried about their children's education. Parents' comments on the curriculum for the odd semester of 2022–2023 for all 4 programmes in the School of Commerce, Finance, and Accountancy were gathered in order to improve education.

The input was addressed by the parents of the relevant programmes. Parents provided feedback on the curriculum using a Google form that asked them about their children's curriculum and syllabus. The replies were collected using a 5-likert scale. According to the parents' comments, a faculty meeting was planned for the School of Commerce, Finance & Accountancy with the Programme Coordinators and the Head of the Department, and it was then decided to address the adjustments with the members of the Curriculum Development Committee (CDC). 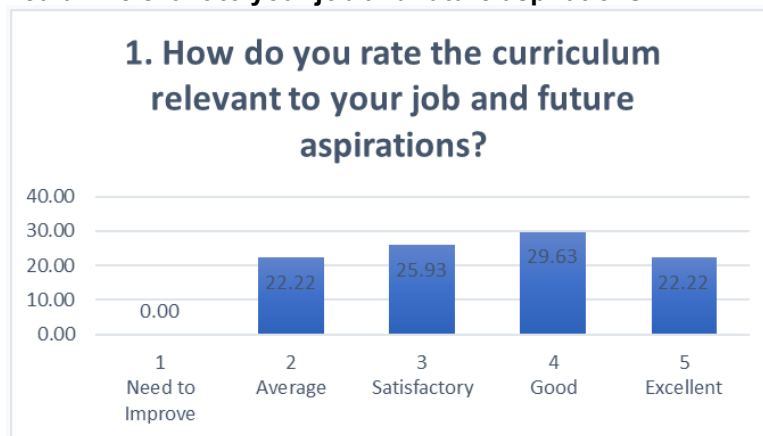

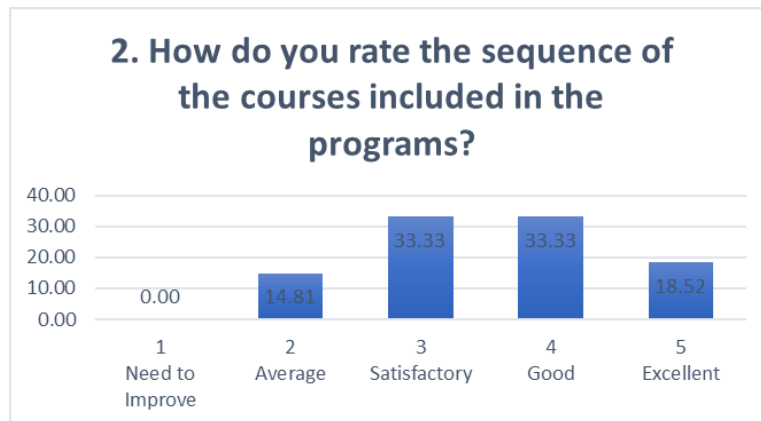

1. How do you rate the curriculum relevant to your job and future aspirations?



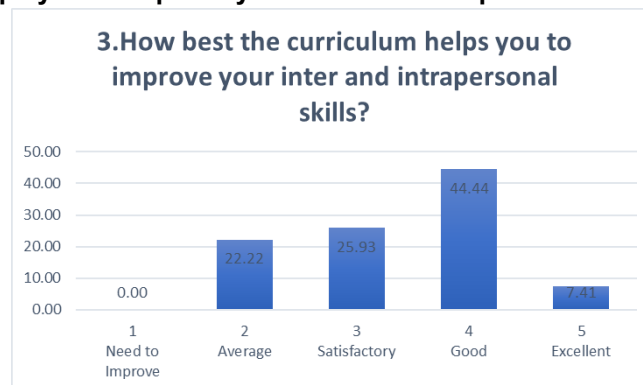

2. How do you rate the sequence of the courses included in the programs?



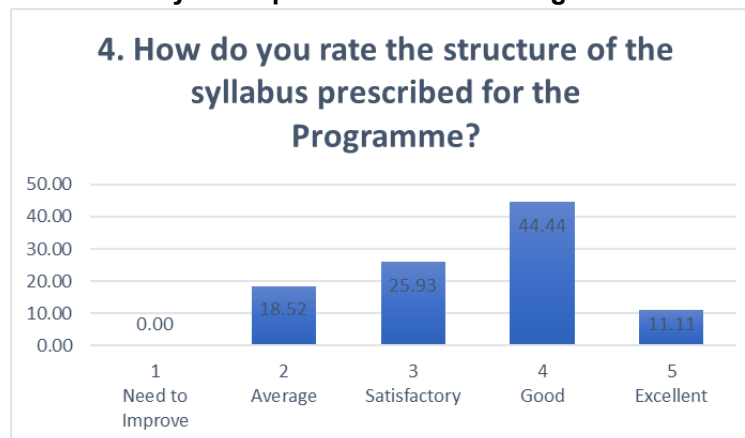

3. How best the curriculum helps you to improve your inter and intrapersonal skills?



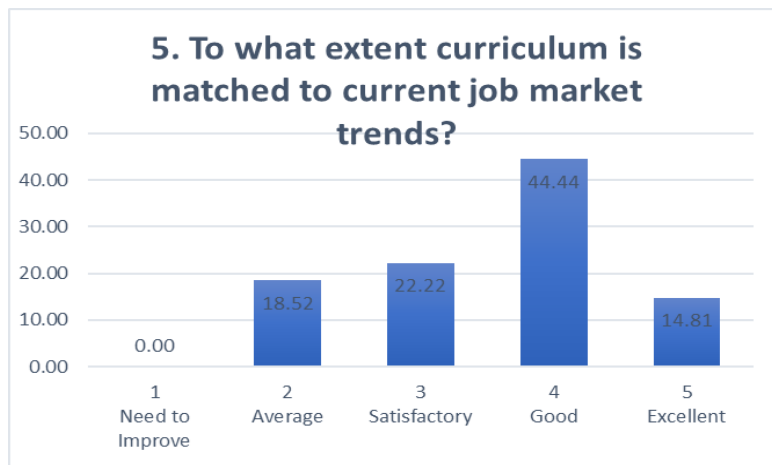
Overall 51.85% Alumnis were satisfied that the curriculum helped them to improve their inter and intrapersonal skill. Out of which 7.41% Alumnis rated excellent, 44.44% Alumnis rated good and 25.93% Alumnis were satisfied.

Overall 55.56% Alumnis were satisfied and said the structure of the syllabus prescribed for the Programme. Out of which 11.11% Alumnis rated excellent, 44.44% Alumnis rated good and 25.93% Alumnis were satisfied.

5. To what extent curriculum is matched to current job market trends?



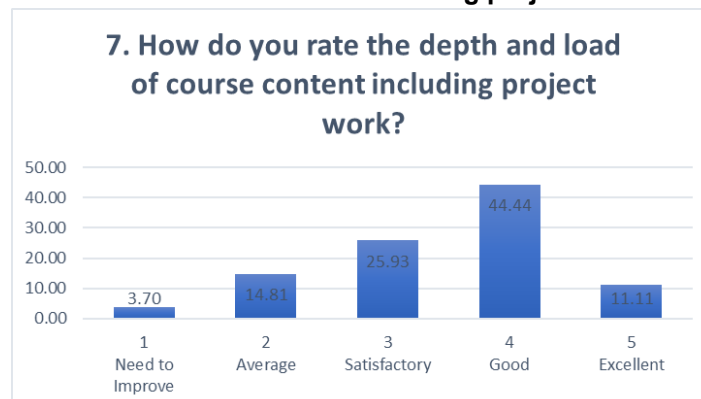

6. Is project work/Internships offered under your Programme challenging and constructive?



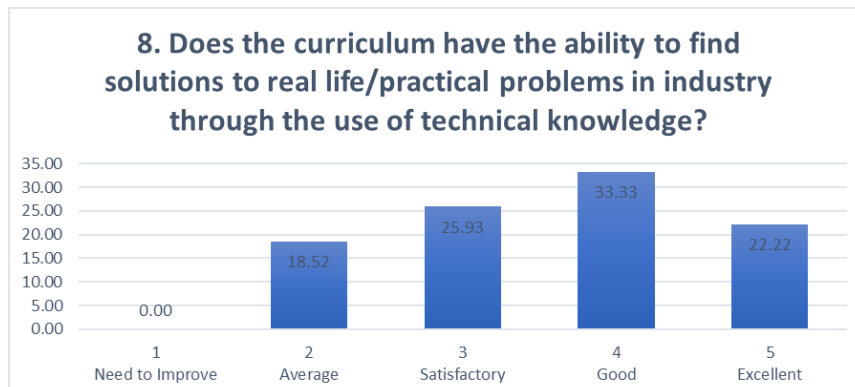

7. How do you rate the depth and load of course content including project work?



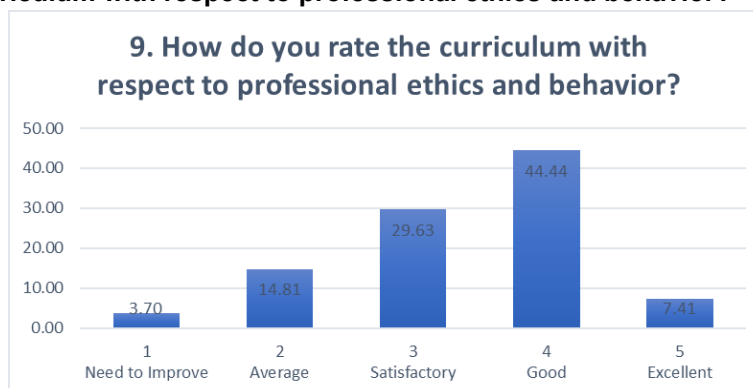

Overall 44.44% Alumnis were overall satisfied with the current program in meeting its educational objectives. Out of which 44.44% Alumnis rated good and 25.93% Alumnis were satisfied.

Action Taken Report

It's important to consider Alumni's feedback. Alumni are better at knowing which students will quickly grasp the material and which would require additional time. In order to improve education, Alumnis recommendations on the curriculum for all 4 programmes in the School of Commerce, Finance, and Accountancy for the odd and even semester of 2022–2023 were gathered.

The Alumni of the respective programmes responded to the input. Using a Google form that asked them about the current curriculum and syllabus, Alumnis provided feedback on the curriculum. A 5-likert scale was used to compile the responses. The School of Commerce, Finance & Accountancy was scheduled for a faculty meeting with the Programme Coordinators and the Head of the Department in response to the suggestions provided by the Alumni's. It was then decided to discuss the modifications with the members of the Curriculum Development Committee (CDC). The meeting was held on February 5, 2023, to talk about the Alumnis responses, and the main points were covered:

- What were the responses of Alumnis ?
- How far are the Alumnis satisfied with the curriculum in the odd and even semester?
- For those who are not satisfied or not given the satisfactory feedback, points discussed on what has to be done in regard to that and how much changes are required in the curriculum in regard to the same?

The curriculum needs to be revised in the areas where Alumnis were dissatisfied, as shown by the histograms given in the report above for various points, it was also decided during the meeting. The faculties have come to an agreement, and the reforms will start to be applied in the following semester.
