Approximately 69% of the students believe that the syllabus enhances your knowledge and skills in the relevant domain, whereas approx. 66% of the students believe that the syllabus is effective in developing critical/ analytical thinking. Under Point 06 of the feedback, it was observed that only 60% of the students are of the opinion that the textbooks and reference materials are relevant to the content of the syllabus, which needs to get communicated to respective course coordinators and other members like CDC, Bos, Academic Council members. Approximately 66% of students believe that the syllabus orients towards higher education and 71% of students believe that the syllabus enables the students to apply their knowledge in real life situations. Next as per point no 09 of the feedback analysis 61% of students are of the opinion that employability is given weightage in the design and development of syllabus and around 67% of them perceive that the syllabus promotes self-study and attitude of research. In response to the last question of the feedback, it is observed that approximately 64% of students are of the opinion that the syllabus meets their overall expectations.

Action Taken Report:

Based on the finding of the study followed by analysis, it has been observed that (as stated in point 06) that only 61% of the students are of the opinion that the textbooks and reference materials are relevant to the content of the syllabus. By stating this point in this report, we wish to communicate the same to respective course coordinators and other members like CDC, Bos, and Academic Council members for their further action and consideration.




Does the syllabus have components to serve the needs of the society? 42 responses



The detailed feedback has been taken from various stakeholders of the BBA FT program during the academic year 2022-2023. In the section under "Parents' feedback on Syllabus", it has been observed that approximately 67% of parents the syllabus of BBA FT programs orients the students towards higher education. Similarly, 42% of parents are of the opinion that employability is given weightage in the design and development of the syllabus. In the same section, under point no 03 of the questionnaires it has also been observed that approximately 48% of the parents are neutral about the same question. Next, approximately 40% of the parents believe that the syllabus is designed to have a component of value-based education, whereas approx. 60% of them believe that the syllabus has components to serve the needs of society. Under Point 06 of the feedback, it was observed that only 64% of the parents are of the opinion that the syllabus promotes self-study and attitude of research. 




Does the syllabus satisfy the stated objectives and learning outcomes? 16 responses






Is the syllabus effective in developing independent thinking? 16 responses






Does the syllabus enhance your knowledge in the subject area? 16 responses



The detailed feedback has been taken from various stakeholders of the BBA FT program during the academic year 2022-2023. In the section under 'Faculty' feedback on Syllabus, it has been observed that approximately 87% of faculty members have more than 5 years of teaching experience. Nearly 88% faculty members are of the view that the syllabus satisfies the stated objectives and learning outcomes. 87.5 % faculty members say that there are processes to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the syllabus. 87.5% faculty members find syllabus to be effective in developing independent thinking. 81.3% faculty agrees that the department level committee usually meets to review the syllabus. 81% faculty members find syllabus to enhance their knowledge in the subject area. 87.6% of faculty members find syllabus to enable the students in applying their knowledge in real life. 81% faculty find the syllabus to be demanding for research inclusive teaching. In general few members have suggested for a revision in syllabus.

Action Taken Report:













The Alumni responded to the Google form that asked them about the current curriculum and syllabus, Alumnis provided feedback on the curriculum. A 5-likert scale was used to compile the responses. it has been observed that approximately 51.85% of Alumni were satisfied with the relevance of curriculum for job and future prospects and the sequence of courses in the curriculum. Nearly 51.85% Alumni are of the view that the syllabus helps them in improving inter and intra personal skills. 55.56% Alumnis were found to be satisfied with the structure of the syllabus. 59.96 % Alumnis said the curriculum matches with the current job market trends. 51.85% Alumnis were satisfied and said the project work/Internships offered under the Programme were challenging and constructive. Overall 55.56% Alumnis were satisfied and said the curriculum has the ability to find solutions to real life/practical problems in industry through the use of technical knowledge. Overall 70.37% Alumni were satisfied with the current program in meeting its educational objectives. In general few Alumnis have suggested for a revision in syllabus.

Action Taken Report:

The School of Business and Management scheduled for a faculty meeting with the Programme Coordinators and the Head of the Department in response to the suggestions provided by the Alumni's. It was then decided to discuss the modifications with the members of the Curriculum Development Committee (CDC). The curriculum needs to be revised in the areas where Alumnis were dissatisfied, as shown by the histograms given in the report above for various points, it was also decided during the meeting. The faculties have come to an agreement, and the reforms will start to be applied in the following semester.
